Vendor Booth Guidelines

- You are invited to apply for vendor booth space at Food Truck Weekend in Lumberton, NC.
- The dates & times of the rodeo are: Fri Oct 13th (5-9p), Sat Oct 14th(11a-7pm), and Sun Oct 15th (1pm-7pm)
- The fee for vendors is \$15 for Friday and \$25 for Saturday and Sunday. The full fee must be submitted with your application, no later than October 14th, 2022. No refunds will be made unless application is not accepted.
- Applications with checks or money orders must be received no later than October 14th, 2022.
- The size of rental space will be 12'x12' and will be located on the streets of downtown Lumberton, NC either in or around the Dick Taylor Plaza. The festival staff will assign spaces.
- We encourage the use of tents and/or canopies; please use them.
- This event will take place rain or shine (each day) unless severe weather has been forecast.
- Set up for All Vendors should be <u>completed</u> no later than
 4:30pm on Friday / 10:30am on Saturday / 12:30pm on Sunday
- Applications must be received no later than September 15th 2023 and applicants will be
 notified of participation decision no later than September 18th, 2023. The number of spaces will
 be limited. The committee will determine space assignments. Requests for specific space
 locations will be honored on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Exhibitors must provide all display props including chairs, tables, electrical cords, etc. All tables should be covered to the ground (with boxes and materials hidden from sight.) We encourage you to plan for inclement weather by using a tent or canopy. Sandbags or similar materials must be used to hold tents in place. You may not use any other anchoring device, such as spikes, due to pavement).
- Artisans are encouraged to demonstrate their craft for visitors.
- After reviewing your application, The Food Truck Weekend planning committee may request examples(photos) of your product/craft.
- If you are a crafter, all work displayed must be handmade, original works of art, by the exhibitor. No kits, commercial molds, imported or resale items. (Commercial exhibitors must state that they are marketplace and submit photographs of items to be sold.)
- The Food Truck Weekend planning committee reserves the right to refuse any unsuitable materials.
- Each exhibitor is responsible for collecting North Carolina Sales Tax.
- Generators are permitted only by special arrangements and must be inspected by the committee.
